Qulliq Energy Corporation prepares to file its second General Rate Application

IQALUIT, Nunavut (November 20, 2009) – Qulliq Energy Corporation (QEC) wishes to give advance notice to its valued customers that proceedings are underway which will result in a general rate application (GRA) being filed in the spring of 2010. This application is designed to ensure the Corporation is financially viable to maintain reliable power generation systems.

To ensure Nunavummiut are aware and fully understand what the GRA process involves, QEC has launched an information campaign that will provide information and updates well in advance of the application being filed.

Beginning this month QEC has taken the following actions to ensure its valued customers are well informed:

- an information letter will be included in this month's power bills
- a GRA webpage has been established on QEC's website at www.nunavutpower.com
- a "one point of contact" has been established for GRA related issues
